1. At 6:55 p.m. on 4 July 1952, a train with four rocket launchers, [redacted] field kitchen, and troops on three boxcars passed through the Littenberg (N 52/B 37) railroad station toward Dessau. \*
2. At 5:15 a.m. on 5 July, a train carrying 60 new, [redacted] and troops 25X1 wearing red-bordered black epaulets in 1 boxcar, passed through the Jaenickendorf railroad station southeast of Luckenwalde (N 53/Z 70) and proceeded toward Jueterbog, coming from the direction of Rössen. 25X1
3. At 8 a.m. on 3 July, a convoy of 20 trucks with billeting equipment, [redacted] each carrying 10 soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulets, drove through Luckenwalde, coming from the direction of Jueterbog and proceeding toward Trebbin. \*\*
4. On the morning of 30 June, an express train consisting of 3 empty cars and 6 to 8 cars occupied to capacity by young officers arrived at Frankfurt/Oder (O 53/V 63) railroad station from the Polish-occupied sector of Germany. After the train had stopped, Soviet soldiers with bayonets fixed appeared on either side of the train ordering the officers to close the windows.

It is possible that a rocket launcher unit from the area of the Third Gds Mezz Army moved to Altnagrebaw for firing practice.

\*\* [redacted] Comment. The convoy with the billeting equipment is probably connected with the transfer of troops in the Juensdorf-Jueterbog area.
