1. On 13 May 1952 at 1000 hours Kurt Gregor, head of the Economic Division of the
SED Central Committee, held a meeting in his office at which the following people
were present:

Ernst Wollweber State Secretary in the Ministry of Transport;

Gerhard Weiss, head of the Main Department Import in the Ministry for Foreign
and Internal Trade;

Kurt Kratz, head of the Machine Construction section of the MAIN.

Also present were representatives from the Ministry for Construction, the Ministry
of Agriculture and the State Secretariat for Coal and Power. The meeting was to
draw up lists, with estimated costs, of machinery urgently required in East
Germany. Seven lists were called for, to cover the
following categories:
