Foreign Troops and Foreign Aid Goods

In late January 1952, the strength and nationality of foreign troops aiding North Korea were as follows: 47 Chinese Communist divisions, 5 Mongolian 40 divisions, 1 Czechoslovakian medical battalion, and 3,000 Soviet advisers. The amount of foreign-aid goods sent to North Korea by that date and their contributors were as follows: 3,000 tons of food from India (F-4), 1,000 tons of food from Hungary, 200 tons of clothing from Rumania, and 30 tons of medicine from Czechoslovakia.

continued aid to Korea and has decided to donate 70,000 cattle to Korea.
