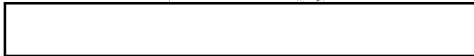

25X1 (1) The information on incoming and outgoing shipments at the large ration supply depot at Frankfurt/Oder, [redacted] of the GOCG, largely checks with previous information, and, thus, constitutes a valuable confirmation. [redacted]

25X1 (2) Depot No 3289 at the winter harbor was previously reported. It is an annex of the ration supply depot in Frankfurt/Oder and serves as a central distribution point of the GOCG for field kitchens, bakery equipment and mess kits. No information on incoming and outgoing shipments has been previously available. However, these shipments appear credible as to volume, receivers and/or dispatchers.

(3) Promivó (fnu), Borieshnikov (fnu) and Aldashev (fnu), mentioned as supply officers in Frankfurt/Oder, were reported for the first time.

(4) The delivery to the central air force depot in Strausberg of these cranes for aircraft was reported for the first time. It is believed that the cranes were distributed to units of the Twenty-Fourth Air Army. No information is available on the type of these cranes. 25X1

(5) The shipments from Brest Litovsk probably went via the shunting station to be marshaled with other cars bound for the same destinations or lines.

25X1 [redacted] The freight station and harbor station handle incoming and outgoing supply shipments for Soviet troops and supply installations in the area of Frankfurt/Oder. The harbor station apparently forms an operational unit with the freight station. Available information indicates that only individual supply shipments from and to the U.S.S.R. are handled at the marshaling yard. [redacted] 25X1

25X1 [redacted] . A total of 1,505 cars was handled during the period of observation. [redacted] the number of cars actually handled must be three times that much. This is equivalent to a daily average of between 45 to 50 cars. Accordingly, the supply traffic during 25X1
