25X1 On 7 August 1952 [] surveying work was being done at the former Jocksdorf glider field near Forst. Lanes were cut into the woods on both sides of the field. Soil tests were made at five different spots. It was rumored that a concrete runway was to be constructed. *

25X1 [] Comment. The former Jocksdorf glider field is about 8.75 km south-southwest of Forst, 1 km southeast of the railroad line leading from Forst to Weisswasser. The adjacent area is similar to the wooded sites in Schorfheide, Buchholz and Mahlwinkel where airfields are also under construction.
