Comments.

- (1) Deliveries by the large East German hydrogenation plant to the U.S.S.R.
- (2) These shipments are connected with the vehicle replacement program.
- (3) These shipments were included in a previous report. There is a possibility that still other vehicle shipments were also reported.
- (4) However, they cannot be identified.
- (5) It is believed that the shipment of 26 September consisted of empty aircraft crates, which had contained aircraft sent from Brest Litovsk to Neuruppin on 4 April 1952.
- (6) It is believed that these arms shipments were consigned to the Volkspolizei.
- (7) The consignee of this shipment could not be determined.
