SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO. 50X1-HUM

1. Two armored cars [redacted] were unloaded on 13 October 1952 at the Liesing railroad station. 50X1-HUM 50X1-HUM
2. A self-propelled gun [redacted] was unloaded from a flat-car on 15 October at the Liesing railroad station. Description of the gun is as follows:
  - a. five aligned, large diameter track wheels; rear sprocket and front idler; no return rollers
  - b. seven to eight centimeters in caliber; an approximately 10.5 foot long barrel; no muzzlebrake
  - c. upper front plate of the fighting compartment sloped at a 45-degree angle and side plates at a 30-degree angle to vertical
  - d. small external spherical gun mantlet with vertical side plates
  - e. small hatch, machine gun mount, and two small cupolas on top of the fighting compartment
  - f. driver's escape hatch on the left side of the upper front plate with a searchlight at its side
  - g. four extra fuel drums in the rear with a capacity of approximately 100 quarts each

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
