- 25X1 1. A bypass railroad line is being built 30 km. south of Warsaw to connect Brest and Berlin. The line is to bypass Warsaw, Siedlce, Minsk Mazowiecki, and Sochaczew.
- 2. The line has two tracks; some of the sections were completed but are not yet in use.<sup>1</sup> A bridge, three to four kilometers southwest of Piotrowice, has been completed.
- 3. One construction section headquarters is located at Mszczonow (R 52/P 66). This section extends from Skierniewice to 23 km. east of Wisla.<sup>2</sup> The chief of the section is Jerzy Szewczyk.

25X1 1.  Comment.  the construction of double tracks along the Pilawa (R 52/L 35)-Parysow (R 52/L 46)-Stoczek (R 52/L 34)-Lukow (S 52/L 95) line was near completion in June 1952.
