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1. Between 9 and 11 a.m. on 10 October 1952, there was air activity over Dresden-Klotzsche airfield. Three Po-2s were observed making local flights. Truck [redacted] entered and left the field.

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2. On 5 October, only one truck of the driving school was observed. It was occupied by eight MI and a driver who was a lieutenant. After 5 October, no drivers' training was given.

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3. [redacted] the rooms on the second floor of the Hansa Building were equipped with double-decker bunks. The building which had a total of 36 rooms, each with four beds, still quartered about 100 men.¹

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1. [redacted] Comment. The occupation of Dresden-Klotzsche airfield has not changed. A rumor, according to which the former officer candidate school is to be vacated for VP air men, has not been confirmed. The field is still occupied by the motor vehicle distributing point and an unidentified air force training unit.
