Wenchou (120-381-28-01)

1. During March 1952 the Chinese Communist normal school in Wenchou (120-40, 28-02) opened a class for 200 women to be trained to collect military intelligence information from the Nationalist-held coastal islands. In May 1952 these women left the school.¹
2. In late August there was a military cadre school in Wenchou at Yingtaokuan (2019/6670/6034) Lane, where 1,000 students were trained every three months.

3. In late August there were two summer culture cadre schools in Wenchou at Tingtzu (0002/1316) Bridge and Yuitien (3768/0076/3013) Lane, where 800 primary school teachers were being trained.²
4. In late August there was a sanitary training class in Wenchou at Tukuo (3256/0948) Temple on the mountain outside of the Sanchiao (0005/6037) Gate, where 300 persons were being trained.

5. In early August the Communists in Chinchiang Hsien and Huian (118-48, 25-02) Hsien started a propaganda campaign against teachers as a successor campaign to the three and five-anti campaigns.
6. In mid-August the Lungch'i (117-44, 24-30) Military Sub-District selected 100 outstanding persons from subordinate units for assignment to the accelerated course of the Fukien intelligentsia training class. After completion of the course these persons were to be used to fight illiteracy. On 20 August, these trainees were at the Ch'ungcheng (1504/2973) Middle School in Lungch'i awaiting motor transportation to the north.
7. On 24 July Communist authorities sent all faculty members and students of middle schools in Foochow to summer camps for thought training.

8. In July Communist authorities in Changp'u (117-36, 24-06) Hsien allotted 60 catties of rice to each needy farm family as an inducement to send the children of the family to school.
9. In July 1952 the former Foochow Young Men's Christian Association School in Foochow was renamed the East China Trade School; the president of the school was LU Tzu-fen (7120/5261/1164). 25X1

10. In late July approximately 60 percent of the university students in Canton were genuinely enthusiastic supporters of the Chinese Communist government. Students had devoted the preceding academic year to the land reform programs, the three and five-anti campaigns, and the aid-Korea movement. Lingnan University was less expensive to attend than SUN Yat-sen University.³

Hunan Province

11. Prior to 20 September 1952⁴ the Communists in Yuanling (110-15, 28-28) were planning to establish a military and political cadre training school for the Miao tribe and had forcibly conscripted young members of the tribe from various hsien including Yungsui (109-26, 28-37), Fenghuang (109-32, 27-56), Chiencheng (109-40, 28-14), Kuchang (109-59, 28-37), and Paoching (109-47, 28-43) for this training.⁵

1. Comment. It is possible that some of these women have infiltrated P'ishan (121-30, 28-06) and Nanchishan (121-04, 27-28).

2. Comment. Other summer political training camps for primary school teachers established by the East China Education Department were reported

3. Comment. During the past semester Lingnan University students had practically no classroom work and were engaged in compulsory work in the agrarian reform work corps, the five-anti work corps, and other Communist activities. In July the Communists were preparing to liquidate the university and transfer its students to the SUN Yat-sen University, according to the 3 July 1952 edition of the Hong Kong Kung Shang Jih Pao,
