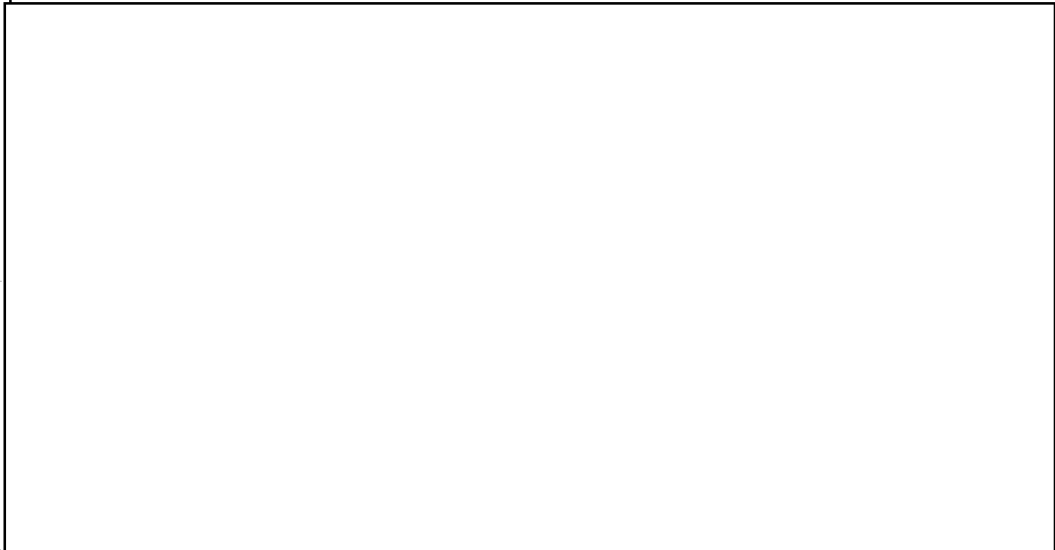
2. [] Comment. These shipments were for the Volkspolizei.

3. [] Comment. The train carried an AA battery back to Werneuchen airfield from Jueterbog where the battery presumably had been for firing practice with live ammunition. It had arrived in Jueterbog on 8 August.

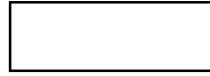
5. [] Comment. These trains carried shipments of air force materiel to air force units. The shipment consigned to Jueterbog possibly was bound for Jueterbog-Damm where an air force repair shop is assumed to be located. In August 1950, a Major Kurachin (fnu) was reported from there. He may be the Kurokhkin (fnu) mentioned in the present report.

6. [] Comment. Nikolayev (fnu) and Stoyanenko (fnu), both without rank, are known, from previous transportation reports, to be stationed in Eberswalde-Eisenspalterei and Depot III at the Lieberose troop training grounds respectively. The other names are reported for the first time.



7.  Comment. Using the figures in the report as a basis during a 24-hour period of observation, an average of 65 carloads was handled per day. This volume of supply traffic corresponds to that of the preceding months, except for the last two-thirds of July. The military supply traffic at the Frankfurt/Oder marshaling yard is normal. The distribution of the shipments are known.
