2. Comment. It is notable that the volume of incoming shipments decreased at all ammunition depots. It is assumed that all large ammunition depots were filled and did need not be refilled immediately after consumption. 25X1

3. Comment. A new ammunition depot for the VP is located on the premises of the former German Army ammunition depot in Guectrow-Priemerwald. According to a previous report, it is planned to reconstruct the spur track to the Priemerburg railroad station. The depot was filled at the beginning of August 1952. 25X1
