NEW UZBEK ACADEMY OF SCIENCES MEMBERS ELECTED

Tashkent FAN WA TURMUSH in Uzbek No 9, 1979 pp 14-15

[Excerpts] The task of increasing the results derived from scientific research and further strengthening the relationship between science and production was discussed in detail at the annual general meeting of the Uzbek SSR Academy of Sciences held on 22-23 June 1979.

The opening speech of O. S. Sodiqow, president of the Uzbek Academy of Sciences and academician, and the report of Q. N. Boymuhamedow, chairman of the presidium of the academy and scholar-secretary, on the research conducted in 1978 emphasized the increase in the scope of research carried out by the scientists of the republic academy of science and the improvement of its quality. The long-range plan for the development of the Uzbek SSR was considered to be among the most significant tasks assigned at the end of 1978.

The reports of the participants of the meeting emphasized the fact that Uzbek researchers had been entrusted with a responsible task--the preliminary work connected with the large-scale project of diverting a portion [of the flow of] the water of Siberian rivers to Central Asia.

O. U. Salimow, secretary of the Central Committee of the Uzbek Communist Party, spoke at the annual meeting of the scholars of the academy. M. T. Tursunow, vice-chairman of the Uzbek Council of Ministers, attended the meeting.

At the meeting of the scholars of the Uzbek science staff, academician O.S. Sodiqow was elected president of the Academy of Sciences of the Uzbek SSR, S. N. Rijow, S. Q. Sirojiddinow, E. Y. Yusupow and P. Q. Habibullayew vice presidents of the academy, and I. I. Iskandarow chairman of the presidium of the academy and scholar-secretary.

Plant Material and Chemistry Institute

In 1943, the alkaloid chemistry laboratory was established at the Chemistry Institute organized within the Uzbek branch of the USSR Academy of Sciences; in July 1956, the Plant Material and Cotton Chemistry Institute, based on the alkaloid chemistry laboratory, was established at the Uzbek SSR Academy of Science at the initiative of Sobir Yunusov; later renamed the Plant Material and Chemistry Institute (FAN WA TURMUSH No 3 1979 pp 16-17)

Samarkand Institute of Medicine imeni U. P. Pavlov

Its ophthalmology department was established in 1933 (FAN WA TURMUSH No 9 1979 p 8)

Samarkand State University

Formerly known as the Samarkand Pedagogical Academy (FAN WA TURMUSH No 6 1979 p 16)

Tashkent Institute To Enhance the Skills of Doctors

Has an ophthalmology department which was established in 1934 (FAN WA TURMUSH No 9 1979 p 8)

Tashkent Polytechnical Institute

Known in 1929 as the Central Asian Industrial Institute (FAN WA TURMUSH No 10 1979 p 20)

Tashkent State University

Formerly was known as the Central Asian State University (FAN WA TURMUSH No 6 1979 p 16) which had a physics and mathematics faculty (FAN WA TURMUSH No 5 1979 p 16) and a medical faculty at which the department of ophthalmology was established in 1920 (FAN WA TURMUSH No 9 1979 p 8)
