MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Security Review of Draft Congressional Appropriations Report

25X1 [redacted] asked me late on 13 April 1978 to review for security purposes a draft appropriations authorization report prepared by Dan Chiles, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence. He said Mr. Chiles intended to release the report at the unclassified level unless provided with specific objections by noon 14 April 1978. The draft report provides dollar figures only for the totals requested and recommended by the Committee for the IC Staff and the CIA Retirement and Disability System. All narrative information in the draft is very general and non-sensitive in nature, and no intelligence activities as such are identified or discussed. The draft states that details on intelligence activities may be found in the classified report. Since nothing in the draft report appeared to meet the tests prescribed for security classification, I advised [redacted] by telephone prior to 1200 on 14 April 1978 that I saw no security objection to issuance of the report as written.
