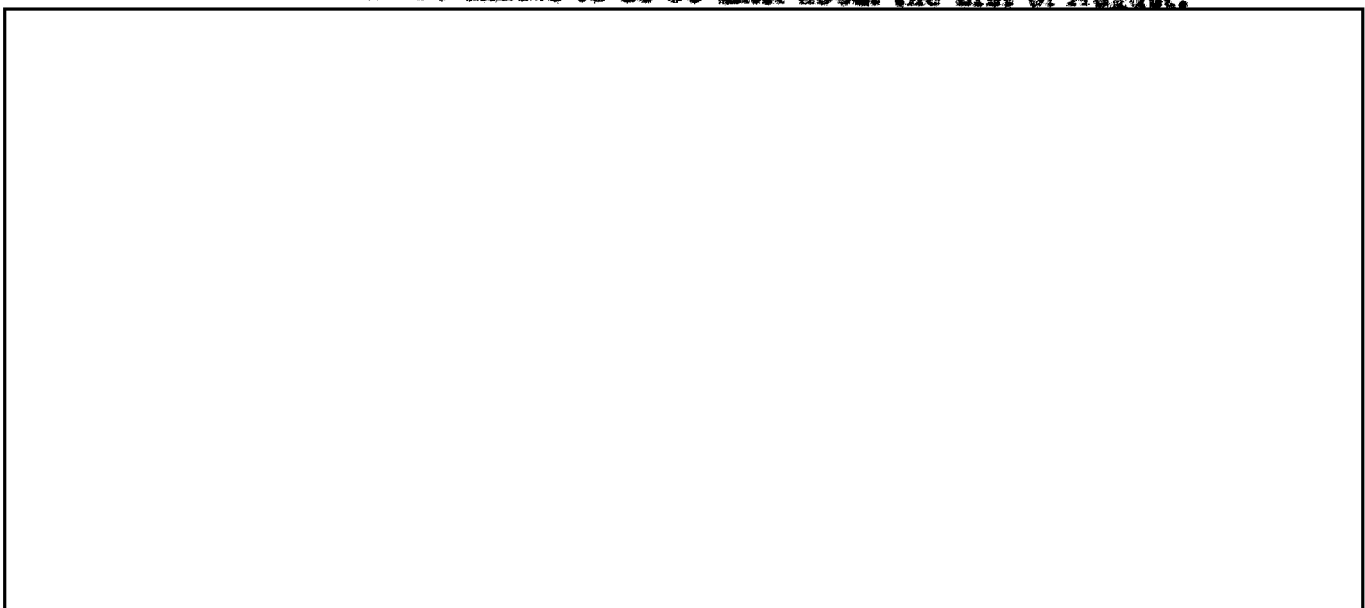

[] Fred Dutton, Assistant Secretary of State for Congressional Relations, telephoned to say that the Senate Foreign Relations Committee will probably call Mr. McCone for a briefing in executive session on the nuclear test ban treaty on 16 August. A memo was forwarded to General Carter regarding this with a copy to Mr. Knoche.

25X1 2. [] Russ Blandford, House Armed Services Committee staff, telephoned to say Subcommittee No. 1 will not take up the CIA retirement legislation bill next week as had been anticipated and the Subcommittee will be unable to do so until about the 21st of August.

25X1 4. [] Handcarried to William Darden, Senate Armed Services Committee staff, General Carter's letter to the Chairman on the budget.
