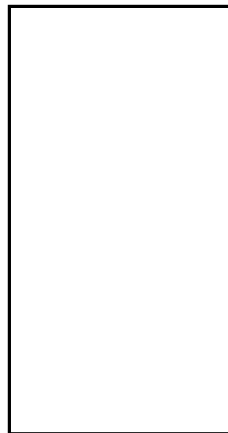
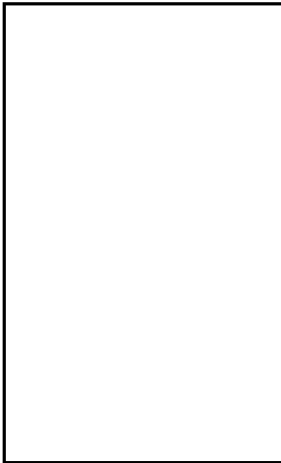

a. Because of the Anderson leaks there will be no more NSC sub-group memos for the record which contain any background information.

b. Dr. Kissinger altered his embargo on discussions regarding the Presidential trip to China. OBGI atlases will be released on a select basis to the press and some members of the press have been invited to Headquarters to review OBGI's memo "Peking and Environs."

c. Mr. Colby, CIA Executive Director/Comptroller, has asked that future nominees for the Senior Seminar be at the supergrade level.

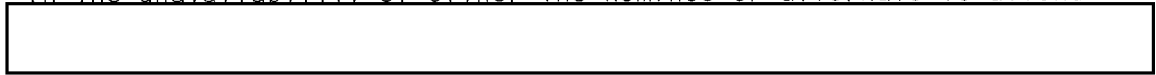
d. Secretary of State Rogers accepted an invitation to visit the Agency for a briefing on 28 January. Impetus was provided by serious cuts proposed in State's intelligence organization INR.
