MEMORATION OF AGRECIATIVE

SUBJECT: Briefing ORD on OPG operations.

- l. To prevent the distortion of CTA intelligence estimates by the covert operations of OPC, it is agreed that the Assistant Pircetor, ORE, be advised of such OPC operations. OPC will issue instructions to its field offices calling their attention to the importance of this matter and requiring them to inform Washington Headquarters specifically of such operations as in their judgment may have the effect of producing distortions of U.S. intelligence estimates.
- 2. It is understood that security will be controlled in accordance with the need to know within ORF. The Assistant Director, CAE, will advise his staff only of these elements of specific operations which might give rise to misinterpretations. With the exception of unusual occasions, which will be the subject of ad hee agreement between the Assistant Director, CRE, and the Assistant Director, OFC, the CRE staff officers who shall be made aware of this type of information will be strictly limited to the Chief and Deputy Chief of the Current Intelligence Group and two key officers in each of such of the CRE geographic divisions as may be concerned.
- 3. The Advisory Staff Officer, OPC, is designated OPC linison officer to the Assistant Director and Deputy Assistant Director, ONE, with respect to covert operations.
