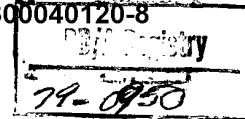



It is suggested that these two items might be appropriate for the agenda of Subject conference. (U)

1. [redacted] Survey of Sensitive Compartmented Information (SCI): It is presumed that the APEX system will be discussed at least for informational purposes. This will present an excellent opportunity to suggest that security processing for APEX/ULTRA access and for any access to the operational systems require polygraph testing, in addition to the criteria now established by DCID 1/14. A discussion of the polygraph at this point probably should be limited only to the concept. (C)

2. Unauthorized Disclosures: The DCI is well aware with our problem in this area. However, it might be appropriate to forewarn the attendees that we should anticipate more leaks as the SALT II treaties become a central point for discussion. I believe we should anticipate leaks on this subject from supporters from both sides of the question. (C)
