COMMUNICATIONS REPORT

1. Total wirefiled FBIS wordage during February 1981 was 229,220, a decrease of 42,590 compared with January 1981. The highest daily total was 11,290 on 7 February, while the lowest was 4,310 on 1 February. The daily average was 8,186 compared with 8,768 in January.

2. All wordage was filed over the Embassy SKYMUX circuit, but for 40 words filed via telex.
