NOTE: Evidently the German Control Administration for the Interior is to be comprised solely of this new police organization and the new agency is to be entitled as such.

For this reason SMIRHOV stated, it had been decided to suberdinate the Administration for the interior directly to SMA, Enricherst. He added that because of its executive functions, the new organisation will be more closely supervised by Seviet authorities than any other Control Administration in the Seviet Zone at present.
