1. The Bulgarian Army is "absolutely unprepared" for biological or chemical warfare; nor are there any projects [redacted] on jet propulsion or similar research.
2. [redacted] the Soviet Union was "magnificently prepared" for bacteriological and chemical warfare.
3. Russian technicians, together with German experts, have perfected the V-2 rocket missiles. Experiments are conducted at Stettin, Germany.
4. The uranium mine at Buhovo, (22 kilometers from Sofia) is being exploited by the Soviets. There are no installations there for the production of heavy water. [redacted] Comment: The voluntary association of heavy water production with uranium extraction is considered significant, indicating the trend of official interest).
5. The uranium is loaded into railroad cars at the Jana Station four miles from Buhovo and dispatched to the Soviet Union. Three hundred workers labor day and night at the mine.
