1. The following activities [redacted] concerning the Warnerunde Harbor:
- a. The SS. "Asia", ex-German K.d.F. liner "Der Deutsche", was being fitted with a short modern funnel."
 - b. The salvaged Hamburg-Amerika liner "Hamburg", now known as "Cordillera", was in the harbor being cleaned.
 - c. Seven small motor minesweepers, about 12 m. long, were under repair out of the water.
 - d. One large minesweeper, mounting a 3.7 cm. gun and a twin MG, was in the harbor for unknown reasons.
 - e. [redacted] four seagoing tugs, all seaworthy, were based in the harbors:

3. Two shovel dredgers and one suction dredger are dredging the channel from the sea up to Rostock.**
4. Two hangar-type buildings, about 100 meters long, have been built at Liebknecht-Werft. One building measures about 60 x 50 meters and the other measures 20 x 40 meters.
