- 1. In the ship repair yard, Wismar (M 54/T 29), nationalized plant, the Soviet passenger ship Ilya Rein is being converted. 25X1
- 2. The ship was built in the Oder-Werke Stettin (O 54/Q 55), her displacement is 1,675 tons, her draft 5.7 meters and her engine power 2X950 HP. 25X1
- 3. She is being converted for passenger service on the Murmansk-Liinachamari route. [REDACTED] 25X1

[REDACTED] Comment:

The vessel is the ex-German steamship Rugard of 1,358 GRT. The steamer formerly plied between Stettin and the Isle of Bornholm and could accommodate 400 passengers. She will now trade between Murmansk and the ex-Finnish Arctic Sea Port and be fitted for overnight accommodations of a large part of the passengers. 25X1
