The a-l set is to teach a pilot student the right approach of and the firing at a target while flying a fighter plane. The instructor is in a position to control the manipulations of the student and to alter the directions of the target with regard to both course and speed. The student, who is seated in a simulated cockpit, has to operate all the controls of a fighter plane. He sees the target, as an image of an aircraft on a screen. He may observe it either with his naked eye or through a sight. Since the seat on which the student is seated does not move the target image on the screen must perform all the movements required to produce the sensations experienced when approaching a stationary or moving target in a flying plane.
