1. Uranium ore shipments of 92 axles each, identified from official records of RBD Chemnitz, which were dispatched to Brest Litovsk via Frankfurt/Oder, between 11 and 18 August 1951, included the following:

2. An original bill of lading for a shipment of uranium ore was obtained in Frankfurt/Oder. The train, whose shipment record was No. K/9350, left Johannegeorgenstadt on 30 July 1951 and was dispatched from Frankfurt/Oder to Brest Litovsk at 17:17 on 2 August. The dispatcher of the shipment, which consisted of 45 freight cars and one boxcar for the eight members of the escorting personnel, [REDACTED]

- 25X1A (2) **Comment:** [REDACTED] 25X1B the Uranium Mining Syndicate in Chemnitz-Hilbersdorf. Shipment record No. K/9350 was also observed by another source in Frankfurt/Oder en route to the East on 2 August 1951.
- 25X1A (3) **Comment:** Uranium ore shipments from the Aue area are dispatched from the railroad area of RBD Chemnitz.
