The majority of the class of 1928 was ~~separated~~ in the fall of 1951 with a long furlough. At this time, personnel in specialized units, or a portion of the personnel ~~with~~ with specialized duties was not discharged. Nor were the men of the border units discharged. This border personnel, the so-called green AVG, usually remains in service from three to five months longer. This is the period of time necessary to allow the ~~newly~~ ~~men~~ ~~of~~ ~~the~~ ~~newly~~ called up class to undergo basic training, after which the selection of men ~~for~~ for the border units can take place. Men of the class of 1928 in the border units were released in March 1952 with a long furlough. It is possible that ~~the~~ ~~some~~ ~~men~~ ~~of~~ ~~this~~ ~~class~~ ~~remain~~ ~~in~~ ~~service~~ ~~if~~ ~~they~~ ~~have~~ ~~specialized~~ ~~skills~~ ~~in~~ ~~specialized~~ ~~units~~. In view of the fact that a large measure of arbitrariness is common in ~~the~~ demobilization, it can not be said with certainty whether or not a portion of the class of 1928 is still in service, and if so, when it will be discharged.

The classes of 1929 and 1930 were called up at the same time: 24 October 1950. ~~WHETHER~~ ~~22~~ these classes are to be discharged in October 1952 ~~xxxxx~~ is not known. It can be assumed that the border units, at least, will be held in service until the spring of 1953.

On 23 September 1952 purple placards with notices for the class of 1932 to report for examination were posted in Budapest. The examinations were to take place during the course of October and the men of this class will probably

be under arms by the end of October or the beginning of November, as usual.
