The attachments described below are propaganda publications circulated by the Partai Komunis Indonesia (PKI) in 1955 throughout Indonesia:

- a. Attachment 1 - is an English translation of a PKI resolution on the world peace movement, and was circulated in March 1955 by PKI committees in Indonesia. In addition to the history of the international peace movement, the role of the PKI in the peace movement is presented. PKI techniques to encourage participation in the peace movement, and an appraisal of the Indonesian weaknesses are enumerated. The resolution concludes with an 8-point set of instructions for the development of the Indonesian peace movement.

The PKI has previously utilized articles translated into Bahasa Indonesia from the Cominform Journal for local propaganda purposes; an article titled "Important Elements in Organizational Work of Communist and Working Class Parties," translated from the Cominform Journal was being circulated in pamphlet form by the North Sumatra provincial committee of the PKI in June 1955
