1. AIRCRAFT (22 Jun 56) 25X1
 (a) Approx 80 MIG 15s and 40 U-MIG 15s. The aircraft are dispersed 25X1

2. AIRCRAFT CRASH
 A MIG 15 from ALTENBURG airfield crashed on Monday, 18th June, after an explosion in the air. The pilot, a captain, was killed.
3. RUNWAY 25X1
 The actual runway ends but 25 hectares of woodlands beyond this point have been felled to facilitate take-off and landing.
4. WORKSHOPS
 Repairs and assembly take place in one of the two remaining hangars.
5. M.T. VEHICLES 25X1
 M.T. vehicles are parked
6. A.A.
 From 9-23 Jun 56, all A.A. guns and equipment left by rail for the USSR at night.
7. GROUND RADAR 25X1
 (a) TOKEN 25X1
 (b) FISHNET 25X1
8. POL 25X1
 (a) From 9-23 Jun 56, 9 2-axle rail tankers arrived from ZEITZ. The source of the fuel was BREWAG, near ZEITZ.
 (b) There are 14 fuel tanks buried Observation indicates that each tank is capable of taking the contents of one complete 2-axle rail tanker.
