- 1. Vicker's Vikings operating in India which have flown in excess of 8,000 hours have been grounded by the manufacturers, following investigation of an accident to a Viking in Tanganyika. It is 25×14 understood that metal fatigue is suspected. Replacement of doubtful parts is expected to take three months. In the meantime DC-3's are replacing the grounded Vikings on Air India's routes.
- 2. The preparations of Air India International to extend services to Tokyo, Singapore and Australia are well advanced.
- 3. It is now confirmed that Air India International's order for three Super-Constellations (delivery 1955) has not been affected by its new order for two Comet Mark III's (delivery 1957).
- 4. The Indian Air Force has ordered 30 Fairchild Packets powered by Jun 23 2 39 PH 753 Wright Compound Motors.
