SECOND PART OF THE FIRST NATIONAL SPARTAKIADE IN PRAGUE OPENS.

On July 2nd the Second Part of the First National Sparta-CPYRGHT kiade, the Senior days opened successfully in Prague overwhelmed by joy and enthusiasm. Early in the afternoon the Strahov Stadium was filled by more than 200,000 spectators both from Prague and from the country. Among the spectators there were also many foreign guests and Czech and Slovak people living abroad. The mighty performance of about 65.000 gymnasts, men, women and groups of dancers in magnificiant national costumes deserved well the enthusiastical ovations almost uninterrupted, which fillied the Strahov Stadium on July the 2nd .
