Progress report for July 1951

1. Inspection and Security Staff has ruled that FBID "Restricted" publications, including the Daily Report, heretofore regarded as restricted for copyright protection only, must be transmitted, stored, and disposed of in accordance with regulations covering other "Restricted" material. FBID has taken steps to comply.

2. Reclassification of FBID positions continues to be effected pursuant to the FBID request of 6 April 1951. Action has been taken on the top jobs departmentally and in the field, on all proposals for the Special Reports Branch, and on administrative assistants and certain monitoring positions in the domestic field. FBID has accepted compromise grades for the monitoring positions.

3. Request has been made for additional native T/O positions for the Cincinatti, Cyprus and Austrian Bureaus to cover increased monitoring requirements and in the case of Austria to relieve HICOG of supplying teletype operators to the Bureau.

4. On the departure of the present incumbent on 1 August 1951, BDC proposes not to maintain a liaison officer with FBID, Washington, continuously in the future.

5. The Table of Organization for the Saigon Bureau was approved by Adviser for Management effective 18 July 1951.

6. FBID is currently rendering special service to Voice of America in the identification of transmitters interfering with VOA broadcasts.

7. At the request of OIR, all available texts of Free Greece radio's "Fighters' Seminar" broadcasts from their beginning on 4 July 1950 were published in a single volume. The material constitutes a textbook of instruction on the theory and practice of Communist activity in Greece.

1. East West Coast Bureau Site.

3. Emergency Station Equipment and Stockpiling.

a. [redacted] (Emergency Station Equipment). Eighty-five of 88 items covered by the project have been delivered to [redacted]. The remaining three items are minor items and should be delivered in early August 1951. The Emergency Station Equipment will be packed and crated for shipment as soon as all items are in.

b. [redacted] (Stockpiling). Sixty of 505 items covered by the project have been delivered to [redacted]. All undelivered items are on order and it is anticipated that most of them will be delivered in August 1951. However, some items are not due until early 1952.

4. Okinawa Construction Project.

A draft project for additional construction at the Okinawa Bureau has been submitted for OO approval. The project proposes:

- a. Typhoon shelter and BOQ structure.
- b. A secure storage house.
- c. Drilling a well.
- d. Bunkhouse for native employees.
- e. Anchor fence around operations area.
- f. Remodeling of one BOQ in the housing area for family use.
- g. Remodeling of club quarters for use by two families without children.

5. Vehicle for Mediterranean Bureau.

Delivery of a 20-passenger bus is expected early in September.

SECRET**III. Local Services Rendered by the Field:****London Bureau**

Daily summaries of USSR, Satellite and German broadcasts are delivered to local users in London and sent by teletype to consumers in Western Europe; i.e., American Embassy offices in London and Paris and The Hague; G-2, USA, Frankfurt; HICOG, Frankfurt; HICOG, Berlin; U.S. Delegation, Austrian Mission; North Atlantic Treaty Organization; SHAPE, etc.

All available transcripts and summaries of broadcasts of the Radio of Free Russia monitored by the BDC are transmitted to the U.S. Embassy in London.

Tokyo Bureau

All processed intercepts are sent to G-2, USA, FEC and the Intelligence Section, FEAF. A copy of the Korean file is transmitted to U.S. Embassy, Pusan, and G-2, Eighth Army via radioteletype. Selected material of Chinese International Service programs is filed to USIS, Formosa.

China Bureau

All processed intercepts are filed to G-2, USA, FEC and Intelligence Section, FEAF. A copy of Peking intercepts is filed to USIS, Formosa. The weekly analysis of Chinese Communist regional broadcasts is regularly furnished G-2, FEC.

Saigon Bureau

A copy of all processed material is filed to Tokyo for G-2, FEC.

Hong Kong Bureau

Copies of Peking intercepts and Vietnam News Agency intercepts are filed to G-2, USA, FEC. G-2, FEC, also receives daily a copy of all Russian-language material and a copy of all material in English and French Morse sent by the Saigon office of AFP to their consumers in Southeast Asia.

East Coast Bureau

Daily distribution of an epidemiological bulletin of the World Health Organization is made to the Office of Scientific Intelligence.

German Bureau

Copies of all processed material are sent to the Economic Branch and to the Radio and Press Branch, Office of Intelligence, HICOG

Austrian Bureau

A daily file of selected material is furnished the Office of the Chief of Staff, USFA. The complete file of the Austrian Bureau is supplied to the Intelligence Coordination Branch, USFA, and to G-2, USFA Rear, Salzburg.

Copies of all processed Soviet Kurdish-language intercepts are air mailed to American Embassy offices in Teheran and Baghdad. A Balkan roundup of significant news items is prepared and transmitted daily as a special service to the Office of Policy Coordination.
