PEARSON: "New Delhi: Our Central Intelligence has secretly offered to organize Tibetan refugees to return to Tibet and wage guerrilla war behind the Chinese lines against Peking. Despite the Chinese war the Indian government has steadfastly refused to permit Tibetan refugees to organize against the Chinese while on Indian soil, so now our CIA has offered to do the organizing instead."

"Central Intelligence: CIA estimates that Russia is now spending over \$1 million a day to feed, supply and bolster Fidel Castro. It's doubtful Russia can stand the drain too long.

* * *

"Washington, exclusive: The Joint Intelligence Board, composed of Army, Navy and State Department experts, has come to a very important conclusion regarding Russian policy, namely, that the Kremlin is opening a new policy based on peace. As a result, the Board doesn't expect any Russian squeeze on Berlin or any other hostile move which previously was expected in retaliation for our tough policy on Cuba.

"CIA Chief John McCone doesn't entirely agree with this, and warns that Russia is merely trying to lull us to sleep. However, Ambassador Kohler in Moscow has reported that Red Army leaders have been relegated to the background and moderates are now running the Kremlin."
