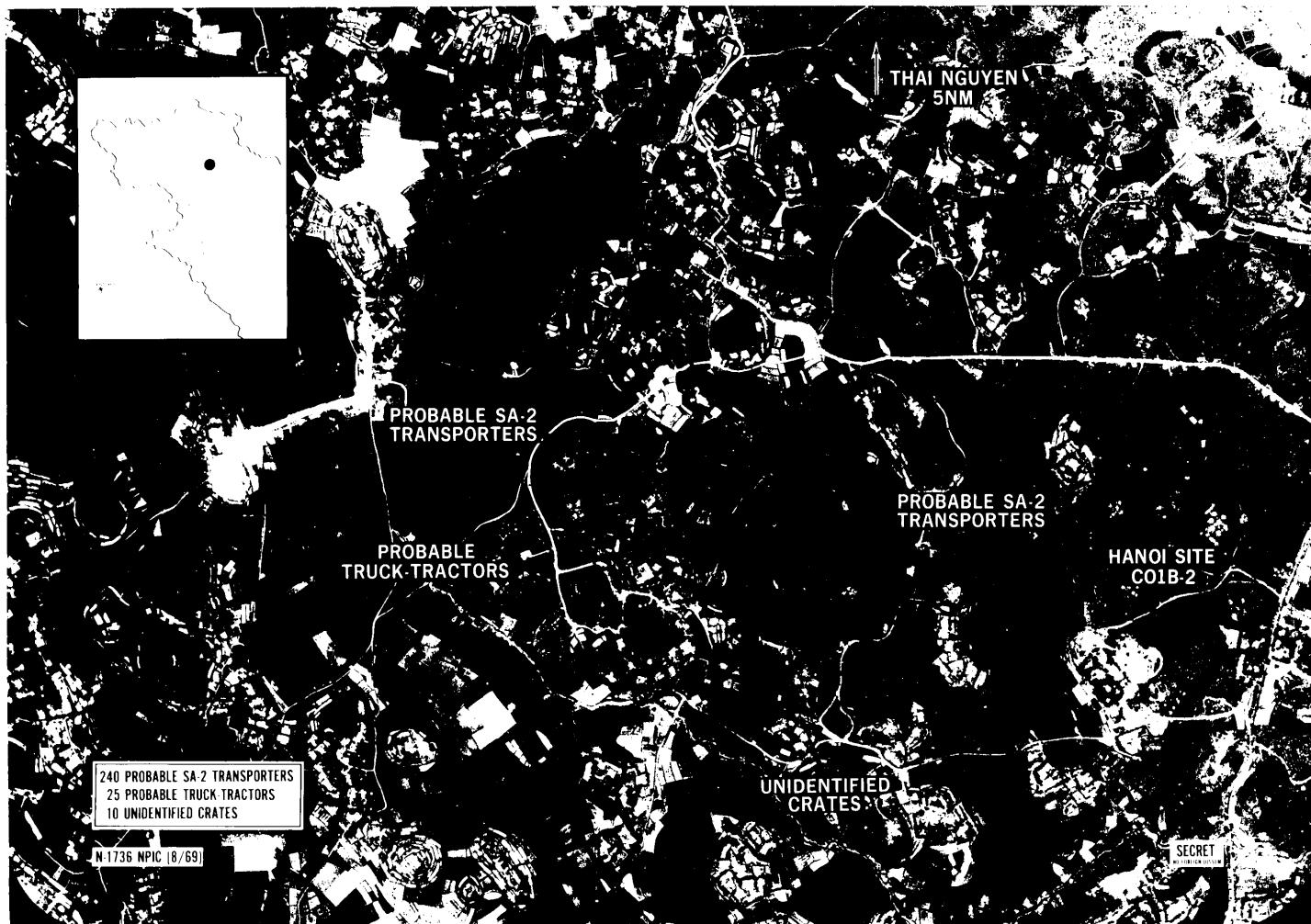

CLOUD FREE PHOTOGRAPHY [REDACTED] OF THE SAME AREA
REVEALS THE PRESENCE OF APPROXIMATELY 240 PROBABLE SA-2 MISSILE TRANSPORTERS,
25 PROBABLE TRUCK-TRACTORS AND 10 U/I CRATES WITHIN A 0.5 NM RADIUS. THIS
AREA WAS ALSO OBSERVED ON PHOTOGRAPHY [REDACTED] WHEN APPROXIMATELY 40
TRANSPORTERS WERE REPORTED.
