PROBABLE LONG DISTANCE COMMUNICATIONS CENTER HANOI, NORTH VIETNAM

1. SIGNIFICANCE:

THIS BRIEFING BOARD DEPICTS THE PROBABLE LOCATION OF THE CENTER FOR ALL LONG DISTANCE COMMUNICATIONS (TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH, AND RADIO) IN HANOI.

2. LOCATION:

IN THE CITADEL AREA OF HANOI.

REMARKS:

THE INSTALIATION SHOWN ON THE BRIEFING BOARD MATCHES,
IN MOST PARTICULARS, THE FACILITIES DESCRIBED IN
THE REFERENCED COLLATERAL REPORTS.

4. COLLATERAL:

COLLATERAL REPORTS HAVE INDICATED THAT THE LONG
DISTANCE TELEPHONE STATION, HANOI CENTRAL RADIO
STATION, AND THE CONTROL STATION FOR THE
INTERNATIONAL TRANSMITTING AND RECEIVING STATIONS
WERE LOCATED ON HUNG VUONG STREET IN HANOI. THESE
REPORTS AGREE ON MANY POINTS SUCH AS LOCATIONS,
NAMES AND FUNCTIONS.

MISSION READOUT: BUMPY ACTION MISSION Q213 REVEALS THAT THE LONG DISTANCE TELEPHONE STATION HANOI CENTRAL RADIO STATION AND THE CONTROL STATION FOR THE INTERNATIONAL TRANSMITTING AND RECEIVING STATIONS ARE PROBALY LOCATED IN A WALL SECURED AREA ON HUNG VUONG STREET. THIS AREA CONTAINS A TWO STORIED PROBABLE INTERNATIONAL RADIO CONTROL STATION WHICH IS SEPRARATED FROM THE OTHER INSTALLATIONS BY A FENCE. THE AREA ALSO CONTAINS A TWO STORIED POSSIBLE LONG DISTANCE TELEPHONE SWITCHBOARD OFFICE WHICH IS ALSO APPARENTLY SEPARATED FROM THE OTHER INSTALLATIONS BY A FENCE OR WALL. TWO ADDITIONAL SIGNIFICANT BUILDINGS WITHIN THE AREA ARE A TWO-STORIED PROBABLE CONTROL BUILDING FOR THE HANOI CENTRAL RADIO STATION AND A WINDOWLESS REINFORCED CONCRETE BUILDING WHICH PROBABLY HOUSES ALL VITAL CONTROL AND SWITCHING FACILITIES. ALSO PRESENT ARE 5 STICK MASTS, 4 VAN TRUCKS, AND SEVERAL SUPPORT, STORAGE, AND SHOP BUILDINGS.
