

MEMORANDUM FOR: Deputy Director for Support

SUBJECT

: Distribution of Monacle Magazine

At 1016 - 16th Street, 15 November 1963

1. This memorandum is for information only.

2. At 0900 hours, 15 November 1963, two men and two attractive young ladies arrived by a station wagon and a Ford sedan in front of 1016 - 16th Street. The two young ladies stationed themselves on the sidewalk in front of 1016 - 16th Street. Each of the young ladies carried a number of inflated balloons, and a supply of "Special CIA Issue" of Monacle Magazine. The balloons were inscribed on one side with the name of the magazine and on the other with the words "Special All CIA Issue." The young ladies proceeded to distribute the magazines to persons entering or leaving the building after first inquiring whether or not they were CIA employees. Apparently copies of the magazine were given only to those who admitted CIA employment. The two men positioned themselves near the Gaslight Club, adjacent to 1016 - 16th Street, and proceeded to take motion pictures of the proceedings. After approximately one hour, the group ceased their activities and reloaded their inflated balloons into the station wagon and left the area.
