SUBJECT : Agency Support to the U.S. Secret Service

1. Attached is a suggested memorandum for your signature to [REDACTED] of the Office of General Counsel. As you are aware, this Office and other components of the Agency are currently lending support to the Secret Service at the Republican National Convention. Therefore, the Office of Security and the Agency, to all intents and purposes is, in fact, lending support under the terms of the new agreement.

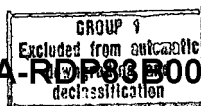
2. Although the possibility exists that Special Agent manpower would be drained by requests from the Secret Service for assistance, it is pointed out that once the Republican and Democratic candidates are selected, this would then entail the protection of only four additional people. At this point, it is not possible to predict whether or not the Secret Service will ask for CIA security agent assistance. However, since we are already lending support and in order to make the terms of the agreement more meaningful, it is recommended that OGC be requested to amend the terms of the original agreement to include Presidential candidates.
