1. Forwarded herewith are the statistics for the Personnel Security Investigations Directorate (PSI) for the month of March 1974.

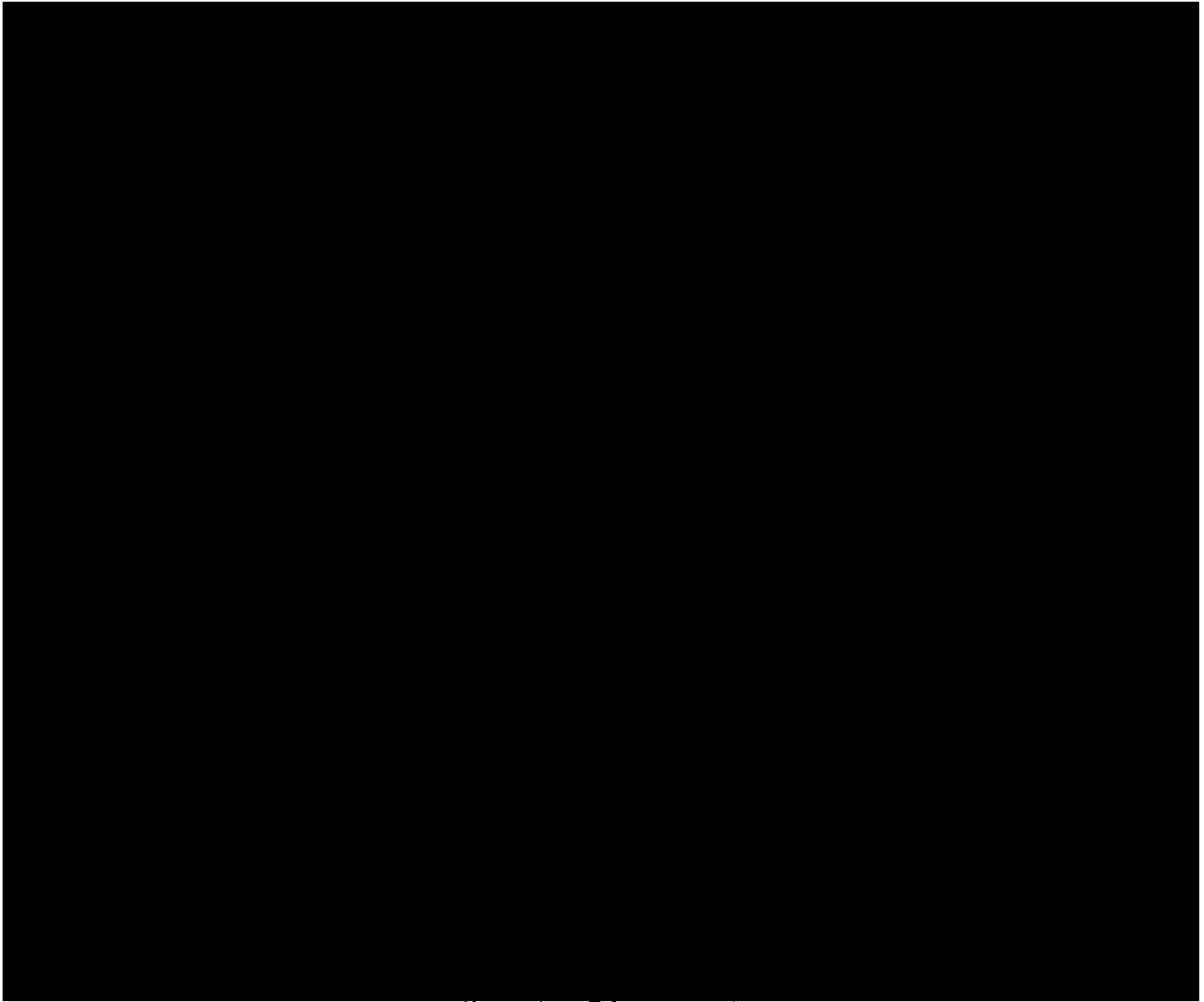

1. 2. Staff and Operations Branch received 30 less staff applicant cases in March than in February 1974. ~~It is noted, however, that the Branch~~ completed 332 more cases in March, which was due in part to the completion of summer employee cases. <sup>simultaneously</sup> In the covert area, 119 less cases were received in February 1974; however, ~~while~~ completions <sup>increased</sup> by 63 cases.

2. 3. Industrial and Certification Branch received 151 more Security Access Approval cases requiring field investigation than in the preceding month of February. SAA cases ~~closed~~ in March, <sup>326 of these cases</sup> by appraisal actions, only were 326, as opposed to 204 in February. Six hundred and twenty-one (621) [redacted] cases were closed in March, as opposed to 323 in February. Receipts of [redacted] cases in March were up 426.
