He will continue to have the [redacted] responsibility and will be assisted by another part-time case officer. It is believed that this Project is very productive and should be expanded to include personnel engaged in char service at the Ames, Key, Magazine and [redacted] Buildings. These buildings are serviced by independent char services with no Government connection, however, they have a high potential for recruitment by opposition services and could do significant damage to the Agency. It is not believed that this additional emphasis would increase the cost of this Project significantly.
