MEMORANDUM FOR: Deputy General Counsel

SUBJECT : Alleged Security and Embezzlement Issues

We are concerned that the [redacted] case is going to be allowed to drag on while events overtake us. We are fully aware of the inhibitions that exist in the Agency conducting an investigation into a criminal allegation, but we feel that these inhibitions cannot be allowed indefinitely to postpone some action. I am unaware of any legal inhibitions on the Agency taking immediate action to resolve the security question in this case, and recommend that you agree that the Office of Security initiate action on that immediately while you arrange with the Department of Justice on the technical details of how to handle the criminal investigation without compromising any follow-on prosecution that may develop.
