The deteriorating economic situation and Solidarity's demands for greater access to the media and a larger voice in industrial management points toward ever more serious tests of strength and will over the next few months. The government's ability to buy peace with increased food or decreased work schedules is limited by economic realities. The government's ability or willingness to meet other Solidarity demands will be limited by Communist Party perceptions of its power and the government's sovereignty. Accelerating economic problems, public frustrations, and the possibility of misjudgments by all elements remain incalculable elements in the Polish crisis.
