5. Staff Position: The services of these proposed STAP members cannot be met by using onboard personnel. Their proposed utilization has been coordinated [redacted] and preliminary clearances from the Office of Security have been received. Each individual's service on STAP probably will be about 10 and no more than 25 days a year. Each member is paid travel and per diem expenses and some accept consultant's pay at a daily rate of the top step of a GS-15. [redacted]
