MEMORANDUM FOR: Deputy Director of Central Intelligence

FROM : John Bross

1. [redacted] called this morning to offer his services as an intermediary to enlist the cooperation of the scientific community in the technology drain area. He is a member of the National Research Council of the Academy of Science and believes that the Council would be helpful as an arena in which rational discussion of this problem could take place. He feels that the impact of your talks to the Association for the Advancement of Science will be quite negative.
