1. [REDACTED] In conversation with [REDACTED]

a. [REDACTED] During a recent trip to Miami, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] who presently maintains an export/import business with Central American nations from Miami, FL. While discussing special operations against Nicaragua and Cuba by private groups, [REDACTED] revealed his knowledge concerning a communist (Cuban) network of weapons/materiel infiltration to Central America through Mexico.

b. [REDACTED] to relieve public pressure against Nicaragua, for approximately 6 months the Cubans have been infiltrating materiel through Mexico--with Mexican authorities blessings--into Guatemala. Reportedly, Cuban fishing vessels leave Cuba full of war materiel and off-load at a small town called Vigia Chico (Bahia de la Ascencion) longitude 88° 25' W, latitude 19° 40' N. While the fishing boats return to the Caribbean to fish in accordance with new Cuban/Mexican fishing rights arrangements, the materiel is transported by train to the small town of Santa Cruz de Bravo longitude 89° 57' W, latitude 19° 32' N. From there the weapons are carried by pack animal through trail networks in Belize and also directly from Mexico to the Peten region in Guatemala.

2. [REDACTED] passing out this information and suggests that his organization, [REDACTED] could develop a surveillance system that could keep track of the weapons infiltration, study its vulnerability and eventually interdict the same. [REDACTED]
