Special Event: On Friday, 16 July, several Congressional staffers from the House and Senate Intelligence Committees and Public Affairs officers from the Departments of State and Defense will visit CIA Headquarters for a Security Awareness Day. Presentations will be made in the Headquarters Auditorium by several senior Agency officials on hostile intelligence services targeted against U.S. officials, technical devices and techniques, telephone security, personal protection and leaks of sensitive information and the resulting damage to U.S. national security.
