It is my understanding that several members of the Cabinet have arranged for full-time personal security services. Presumably, these services are funded out of agency appropriations. Since no act of Congress specifically authorizes the provision of security services to secretaries or their assistants, I would like you to answer several questions regarding your own policy on this subject.

- 1. Do you use any security guards for personal protection in Washington and/or when you travel around the country?
- 2. Do any other officials of your department receive similar security? If so, who and why?
- 3. What is the cost of providing security services for the Secretary and other officials? At a minimum, I would like to know the salaries and travel expenses of security personnel.
- 4. Has your department acquired any new equipment to enhance security protection for officials? If so, describe the equipment and its cost.
- 5. If you only use security personnel on a part-time basis, please provide any information on the frequency of use and the cost.

I would appreciate a response to these questions as soon as possible and I would like you to contact Douglas Lowenstein of my staff (224-2315) to keep him apprised of your progress. Meanwhile, thank you for your cooperation.
