I. DCI/DDCI-Assigned Tasks

-- NIO/NESA continued to provide talking points for the DCI on the Lebanese crisis and the Iran-Iraq war, and he prepared a memorandum for the DCI describing the worst-case view of the Iran-Iraq conflict.

-- NIO/Economics prepared talking points for the DCI for the NSC meeting on US-West European relations.

II. Other Activities

-- NIO/EA testified on Taiwan's military needs before the House Foreign Affairs subcommittee on Asian and Pacific Affairs. He also briefed a delegation of Senate staffers en route to Beijing.

-- C/NIC attended a meeting of the Defense Policy Board today.

-- Acting NIO/USSR-EE attended a session at CSIS on their project concerning the USSR in the 1980s.

-- NIO/GPF briefed Gen. Stilwell (DVSD/Policy) on 15 July on the GPF estimates program. Gen. Stilwell showed particular interest in military estimates on the Far East. A similar briefing is being given to Gen. Richardson (Army DCOS/Operations) today.
