OFFICE OF REPORTS AND ESTIMATES

As the exclusive intelligence evaluation, research and production component of CIA, and in accordance with NSC and CIA plans, policies and procedures:

1. Coordinates the formulation of the National Intelligence Objectives by ORE, in collaboration with the IAC agencies and under guidance of the NSC staff.
2. Produces and presents national intelligence required for the formulation and administration of U.S. national security policy and operational decisions.
3. Assesses the adequacy, accuracy, relevance and timeliness of intelligence information and intelligence, and formulates intelligence requirements priorities to assure that all significant fields of intelligence bearing on the national security are adequately covered.
4. Coordinates the development of intelligence requirements of the Intelligence Advisory Committee agencies and recommends plans, policies and procedures for coordinating the production of intelligence by government agencies to promote a coordinated national intelligence effort.
5. Assists ICAPS in preparation of plans, policies and procedures for inter-agency intelligence activities and centralized intelligence service.

Assistant Director for Reports and Estimates

Plans, directs, and supervises the coordination, planning, research, formulation of requirements for, and the production of national intelligence, approving and authorizing the publication of national intelligence reports and estimates.
