ABSTRACT

In this memo AD/SI compared the Alsop article titled, "The Kremlin's Growing Stockpile," with a Joint Atomic Energy Intelligence Committee* estimate, pointing out the similarity of statistics, intelligence information and estimates contained. The possibility of a security leak is suggested.

Executive McConnel replied on 17 October 1950 that Chief Security, Col. Edwards, advised no action be taken but in conjunction with AD/SI could review adequacy of current controls on written data.
