Attached is Youcher No. 219628 and a copy of memorandum of 18 March 1947 from the Chief, Finance Division to the Executive for Personnel and Aichistration. As noted in that memorandum payment of these c harges constitutes illegal payment as maintenance of a telephone in a private residence can in no sense be considered a covernment obligation.

You will note that on Page 9 of the billing which supports the enclosed voucher two charges are stated to be for residence of Colonel aright and residence of General Vandenberg. These entries speak for the solves as improper charges to the government. This and the previous rouchers are due for audit according to present plans during the week of 23 June 1947.

In view of the fact that payment of these items has been made against expected reinbursement by the persons concerned exception on those items would reflect seriously on the administration of Finance Lineson unless payment is received prior to audit.
