Dear General Tighe:

We will be pleased to provide the assistance requested in your letter of 16 December 1980 (U-274/DG), namely access for two of your personnel to DYNAMO software on CIA's VM system. As you have anticipated, we will require that [redacted] be polygraphed as a part of the clearance process which is a prerequisite for access to CIA's online computer systems. Please have him complete one of the attached Personal History Statements (PHS) and ask your security officer to provide us with written certification of his Top Secret clearance and the date of the most recent background investigation. [redacted] should complete the other PHS form. We will also need a certification of her Top Secret clearance, but no polygraph will be required.

Once clearances are complete, we suggest that [redacted] and [redacted] use the facilities of our Office of Training and Education (OTE), well known to [redacted] for access to computer terminals linked to our VM system. The necessary user identification codes and passwords will be available at OTE.

If their requirement extends beyond 90 days we would plan to move them from OTE to a terminal located in our Headquarters building. In the long run you may want to acquire a copy of DYNAMO to run on DIA's own computers, but in the meantime we are happy to be of service.

Dear Admiral Turner:

This is to let you know that I have established the Office of Systems Simulation. It will report directly to me, outside DIA's regular line and staff organization. This office is an outgrowth of a pilot simulation model successfully demonstrated by the GDIP Staff in late Spring.

The pilot model was an initiative to find a way to see the effects of changes in collection on processing and production. The methodology shows great promise. It will give us a way to deal effectively with some of the more difficult resource problems we will have to contend with in the 1980's. We will share the results of our studies with all program managers in the NFIP.

Dr. John Griffiths and Mrs. Sheryl Shreckengost will develop the simulation models. It would be very helpful if they could have access to the DYNAMO software on CIA's VM system. It has more capability than any other in the Community.

Mrs. Shreckengost was a fully cleared CIA employee with a staff badge when she was on rotational assignment to your Information Science Center from September 1977 through August 1979. She used the VM system daily in her duties as course director and instructor in System Dynamics. Dr. Griffiths will be available at your convenience for polygraph and any other processing that may be required.
